

- What Role Do California Offshore Platforms Play as Fish Habitat?

Dr. Milton Love is a research biologist at the Marine Science Institute, University of California, Santa Barbara. He has conducted research on the marine fishes of California for over 40 years and is the author of over 90 publications on the fishes of the Pacific Coast. He has written such books as Certainly More Than You Want to Know About the Fishes of the Pacific Coast and A Guide to the Rockfishes, Thornyheads, and Scorpion Fishes of the Northeast Pacific, and The Rockfishes of the Northeast Pacific. For the past 18 years, using a manned research submersible, Dr. Love has carried out surveys of the fish populations living around natural reefs and oil/gas platforms throughout the southern California Bight.


Progressive Dinner Fun
